<p>All children are encouraged to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Become healthy, independent and responsible members of society;</li> <li>• Build and maintain successful relationships</li> <li>• Become active citizens, responsibly participating in society around them</li> <li>• Achieve and believe in themselves, creating active, confident members of the community</li> <li>• Develop the vocabulary and confidence needed to articulate their thoughts and feelings in a safe, trusting, respectful environment, taking what they have learnt to their everyday interactions from the classroom to the wider community.</li> </ul> <p>As part of our PSHE provision at Westgate, we aim to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• develop the knowledge, understanding and skills children need to manages their lives now and in the future.</li> <li>• equip children with essential skills for life such as resilience, confidence, reflection, empathy, independence, respect</li> <li>• develop the whole child to provide them with the knowledge, skills and attributes needed to protect and enhance their wellbeing.</li> <li>• Teach children how to stay safe and healthy, and to know when and how they can ask for help.</li> <li>• Provide our pupils with a broad range of opportunities, including a range of educational visits and opportunities to work in partnership with a variety of community groups</li> </ul>	<p>As part of this planning process, teachers need to plan the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Linking the PSHE curriculum to the school's INSPIRE vision and British Values;</li> <li>• Creative approaches to lessons such as role play, games and discussions;</li> <li>• Opportunities to discuss existing knowledge and experience at the start of a lesson and to consolidate and reflect upon learning at the end;</li> <li>• Trips and visits from experts who will enhance the learning experience;</li> </ul> <p>As part of this assessment process, teachers will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Identify areas of weakness and seek support from the PSHE lead or organise CPD.</li> <li>• Make links to INSIGHT learning behaviours</li> </ul> <p>The PSHE lead will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Support staff, as required in planning and assessment.</li> <li>• Support staff, with CPD and training</li> </ul>	<p>Impact is measured by ensuring that children develop the knowledge, skills and attributes they need to succeed at school and in the wider world.</p> <p>All children will have:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• An understanding of the British Values of Democracy, Tolerance, Mutual Respect, Rule of Law and Liberty.</li> <li>• A richer vocabulary which will enable them to articulate their understanding of taught concepts</li> <li>• High aspirations, which will see them through to further study, work and a successful adult life.</li> </ul> <p>In addition, we measure the impact of our curriculum through the following methods:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Creation of class PSHE books</li> <li>• Monitoring and analysis of pupil progress;</li> <li>• Pupil discussions about their learning;</li> <li>• Termly whole school SMSC/theme days</li> <li>• Termly assessment using Insight</li> </ul>
