Christmas at Westgate

December is fast approaching and we are pleased to give you some further information about what we have planned to mark Christmas. We look forward to welcoming you into school to help us celebrate during these last few weeks of term.

Friday 5th December – Christmas Fair (3.30pm - 5pm)

Thank you for all of your tombola donations today! We look forward to welcoming you to the Fair on Friday 5th December from 3.30pm. In addition to the tombola, there is a raffle, Santa's Grotto, face painting..... and lots more!

Detailed information about the Fair will be sent out next week.

Slots for Santa's Grotto will go on sale later today, payable via the Arbor School Shop. Slots are available from 3.30pm and will cost £3 per child. You will be able to sign up for your chosen time in Arbor. Santa's Grotto is for children in primary school (up to Year 6) and **younger** siblings. When booking, please book using the account of one of your children and then buy multiple tickets, one for each child in the family. Also, please add in the age of each child that you wish to book for in the notes field. e.g. age 2, 5 and 8 years old.

Children in After School Club will be given the opportunity to attend the Christmas Fair with Miss Clifton and Mrs Green. Please send any spending money for this into school in a named envelope.



Christmas Jumper Day – Thursday 11th December



It is Christmas Jumper Day on Thursday 11th December and children are welcome to come into school in non-uniform, wearing a Christmas t-shirt/jumper – or something Christmassy .

KS2 (Years 3 - 6) Christmas Carols – Thursday 11th December (2.45pm)



We invite you to come and join in with the KS2 Christmas Carols on Thursday 11th December, which will take place on the main playground – so please wrap up. The carols will begin at 2.45pm but you are invited to arrive in school from 2.15pm via the School Office. Hot drinks and mince pies will be on sale (cash and change please!) to take onto the playground - thank you to the PTA for their support in this. There will be no charge to attend the Carol Singing and you are warmly invited to join in with the carols – the words will be available for those of you who wish to sing along.

EYFS Christmas Performance – Tuesday 16th December (9.30am)

We look forward to seeing our Reception children in their first ever school production. This year, the performance will be 'Ready Steady Elf'. Tickets for the performance will cost £1.50. Due to fire regulation restrictions, we can only admit a limited number of parents/carers to each performance so each child has been allocated 2 tickets. There will be an option to request an additional ticket, should any be available once the main booking period has been completed. Additional tickets will be on a first come, first served basis.

Tickets will go on sale on Friday 28th November via The Arbor School Shop and will closes on Thursday 11th December. Please note, there will be no paper tickets.

We ask that you come into School via the school Office, where you will be checked off a list before going to the hall.



KS1 (Years 1 and 2) Christmas Performances – Tuesday 16th December (2pm) and Wednesday 17th December (9.30am)

This year, our Year 1 and 2 Christmas performance will be 'The Fleece Force'. There will be 2 performances:

- **Tuesday 16th December (2pm)**
- **Wednesday 17th December (9.30am)**

Due to fire regulation restrictions, we can only admit a limited number of parents/carers to each performance so each child has been allocated 2 tickets. You can choose to have those tickets at the same performance or one in each performance.

Tickets for the performance will cost £1.50 each and will go on sale via the Arbor School Shop **from Friday 28th November and will close on Thursday 11th December.**

Please ensure that you purchase tickets for the correct day as there will be 2 school shop items; **one for Tuesday and one for Wednesday.** For example you can book and pay for one ticket for each day or 2 for the same day, but no more than 2 per child in total.

Please note, there will be no paper tickets. On the day, we ask that you come into school via the School Office, where you will be checked off a list before going to the hall.

Last day of term - Toy Day

Children are invited to bring a toy or game into school to play/share on the last day. Please do not send anything electrical – no tablets, phones or consoles. Please send toys/games in a named bag. Do not send in anything of value as we cannot guarantee that it will not get lost or broken.

In the morning, the children and staff will walk down to St Peter's Church for a Christmas Service. Nearer the time, we are likely to see if there are any volunteers to walk to and from the church with us.

Please bear with the Office Team if there are any hiccups in the run up to Christmas.
