Reading

We are adjusting the way we change books, to ensure everyone's books are being changed regularly. Please send your child's **reading book and reading record everyday** so they have it to read to an adult in school. We will be sending home 2 books every week and changing one of them **every Monday and Friday**. Your child will be able to choose which book they change and their new book. At this early stage in reading it is important children are developing their fluency. This is improved by re-reading their books, enabling them to identify words more easily. **So please do try to read a book at least three times and record this in their reading record.** Any questions please do see your child's class teacher.
