Sports Days 2026

We are looking forward to fitting our Sports Days in before the end of term. Let's hope that the weather is kind to us!

KS1 Sports Day (Years 1 and 2) = Wednesday 1st July (2pm)

- Enter school via the Car Park or Spread Eagle gates
- Gates open from 1.45pm – please head to the field upon your arrival
- Sports Day starts at approximately 2pm
- Sports Day itself will last around 1¼ hours
- Children will return to their classrooms at the end of Sports Day
- Children will be collected from their classrooms as normal at the end of the day



Reception Sports Day = Thursday 2nd July (9.20am)

- Enter school via the Early Years or Spread Eagle gates – these gates will close as normal at 9am
- Sports Day starts at approximately 9.20am
- Parents to wait on the Early Years playground for the classes to come out following registration
- Sports Day itself will last around 1 hour
- Exit school via the Early Years or Spread Eagle gates

KS2 Sports Day (Years 3, 4, 5 and 6) = Wednesday 15th July (2pm)

- Enter school via the Car Park or Spread Eagle gates
- Gates open from 1.45pm – please head to the field upon your arrival
- Sports Day starts at approximately 2pm
- Sports Day itself will last around 1¼ hours
- Children will return to their classrooms at the end of Sports Day
- Children will be collected from their classrooms as normal at the end of the day

***We are aware that some Year 6s are at a transition day at St Benedicts but with a busy calendar, this is the only day that we could accommodate the KS2 Sports Day.*

As with previous Sports Days, the children will complete a number of different events, such as running, skipping, egg and spoon, and hurdles. Parents will be able to watch each event by following the classes, around the outside of the field. A space for parents will be clearly marked out.

Just a gentle reminder that photographs should not be taken during the Sports Days as some of our children cannot be photographed. On the days, Westgate staff members will take photos and share them on the website, Instagram and Tapestry.

On the Sports Days, we ask that your child/ren come to school in their PE kit (plain T-shirt, plain black/navy shorts or jogging bottoms and trainers). Each child will be put into a team (Blue, Red, Green or Yellow) and their class teacher should have already sent a note home telling you their team colour. We would be grateful if their plain T-shirt matched their team colour, where possible. If you cannot remember the colour needed, please speak to your child's class teacher or contact the School Office. We will have coloured stickers for any child that does not have coloured t-shirts.

We look forward to welcoming you all on these days to support your child/ren. At Westgate's Sports Days, the focus is on fun, participation, and encouraging all the children to do their best. It is always lovely to see parents being so positive and supportive when cheering the children on — it's about confidence, teamwork, and enjoying the day together.
